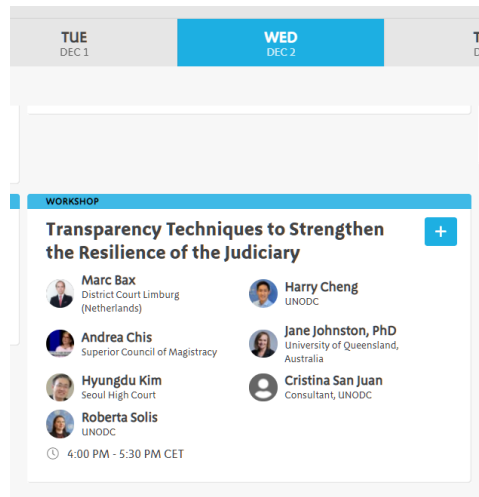

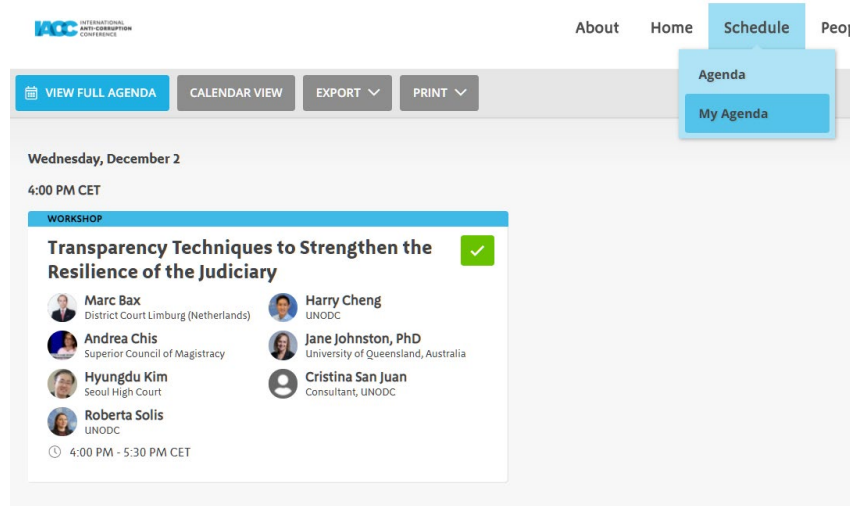

The following instructions will describe (1) how to create an account in Pathable, (2) how to add the Judicial Integrity session to your agenda, and (3) how to join the session at the scheduled time. Adding the session to your agenda is highly encouraged, as the system will generate an automated reminder e-mail for you shortly before the start of the session.

1. The Pathable homepage for the IACC is here: <https://19thiacc.pathable.co/>. When you visit the site for the first time, click on "SIGN IN" and then "Create new account" to create an account. Fill the required information to create an account and complete a basic profile.
2. You can access an agenda of all sessions from the "Schedule" button in the top menu. You can find the Judicial Integrity session by navigating the calendar to 2 December 2020 in the timeslot beginning at 15:00 GMT (see above for other time conversions). You may also search for "Judicial" in the search bar to find the session.
3. When you have found the session card, click the blue (+) sign to add it to your calendar.



- Now, it is possible to access the session card through your personal agenda. From the “Schedule” button in the top menu, click on “My Agenda” to access your saved sessions.



- If you click the session card, you can read more information about the session and speakers, access documents posted by the organizers, submit questions, or answer any available polls. A countdown will show the time remaining to the start of the session.
- On the exact date and time of the event, the session information page will have a button called “JOIN MEETING” in place of the countdown. Clicking this button will launch the meeting through the “Zoom” platform.
