Webinar 'An introduction to Forensics and DNA in casework'

This webinar provides an introduction to forensic disciplines and forensic investigation, with a focus on war crimes situations. The importance of the chain of custody is discussed. Particular attention is paid to forensic DNA investigations. The judge's and prosecutor's point of view is central to this webinar. How should he or she assess forensic evidence in such cases?

With a background in medical analysis, genetics and international crime scene management she served as a serologist/DNA expert for 15 years and headed multiple international missions as a Team Leader. Jeroen Warnaar is a Forensic expert of biological traces and DNA at the Netherlands Forensic Institute. After finishing his studies and PhD in biology he joined the institute in 2007. Since then he has reported more than thousand forensic DNA investigations, ranging from murder cases, sexual assault cases and armed robberies.
