The call for applications is issued between September and mid-October for long-term training periods in the coming year.

## APPLICATIONS

All applications must be submitted between September and mid-October. Applicants must have the authorisation of their national hierarchy to be detached for a long-term training period prior to applying.

When French is the working language (CJEU), applicants must provide proof of their language knowledge.
